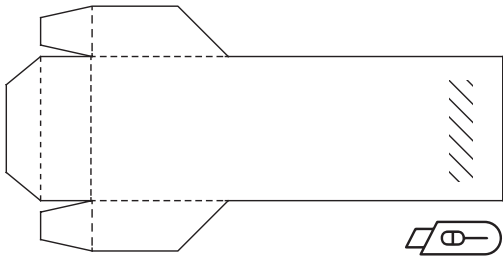


Instruction Manual

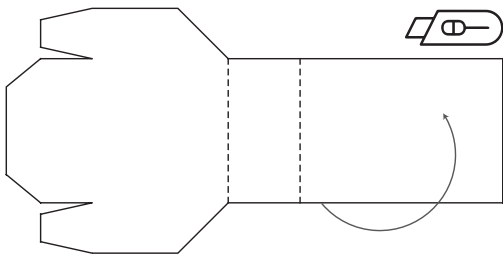
 Cut or Score

 Glue



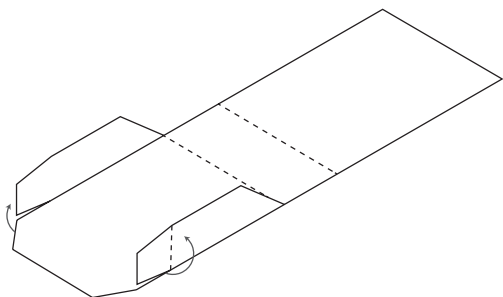
Step 1:

Cut along the black lines of the card mount, and score along the dotted lines. (To score is to etch a line in paper or cardboard so that the cardboard can be folded on that line.)



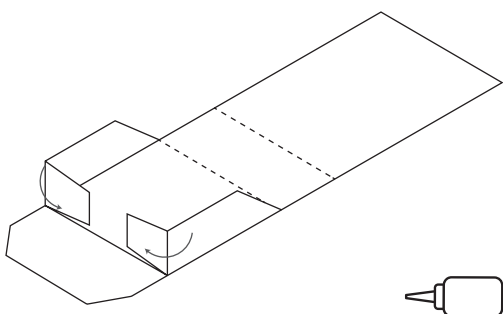
Step 2:

Flip the card mount and score along the dotted line.



Step 3:

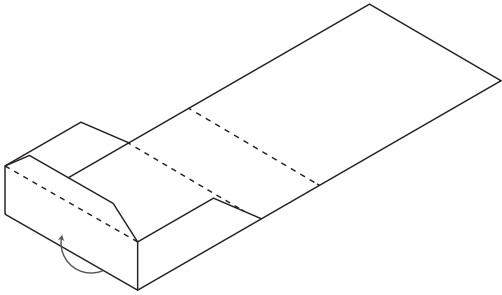
Bend the sides upwards (90 degrees).



Step 4:

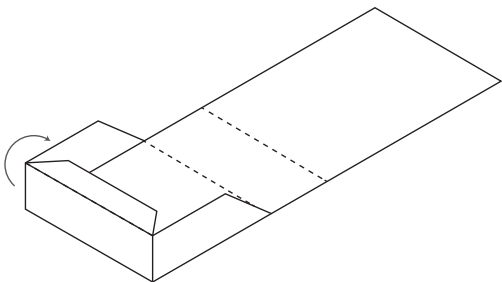
Bend the supports for the base and add glue on the backside of the supports facing the base.





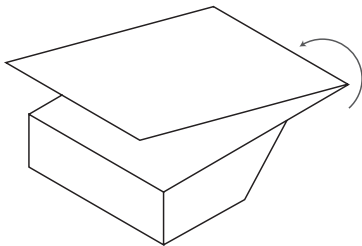
Step 5:

Bend the base upwards and wait for a few seconds for the glue to be activated.



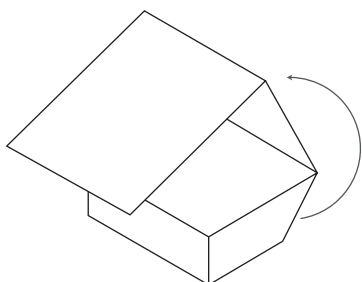
Step 6:

Flip the top part downwards, this will act as a handle for the cards.



Step 7:

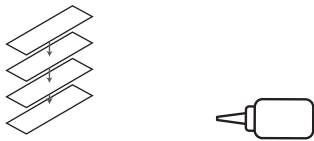
Flip the model and bend the back until it meets back to back with the card mount.



Step 8:

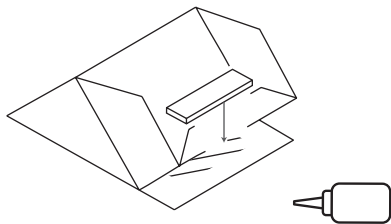
Fold the cardboard along the other scored line.





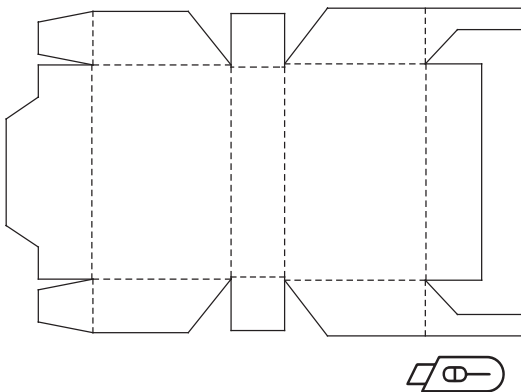
Step 9:

Cut the strips of paper and glue the 4 strips one on top of the other.



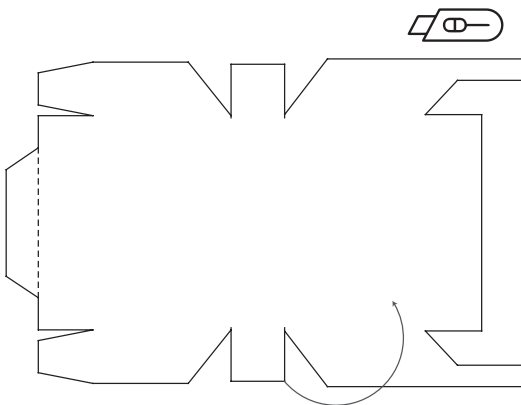
Step 10:

Glue the strips on the diagonal lines (NAC logo facing the top) to finish the card mount.



Step 11:

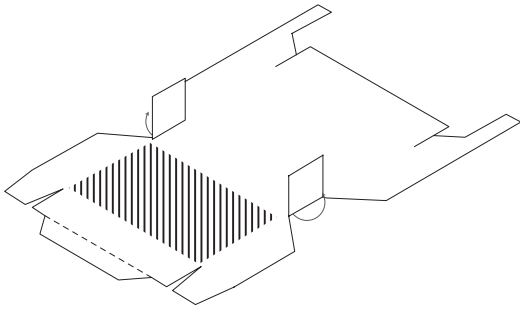
Cut along the solid line of the outside box and lightly score over the dotted line.



Step 12:

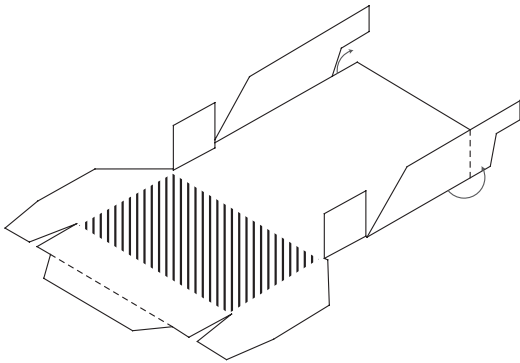
Flip the model and score over the dashed line.





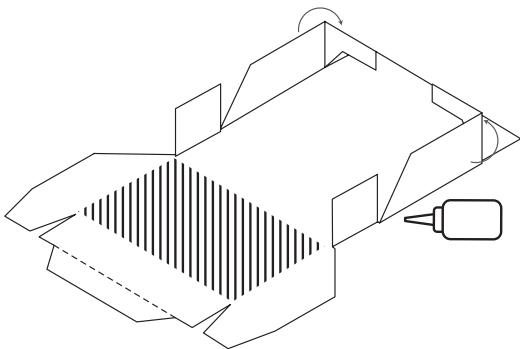
Step 13:

Flip up the sides.



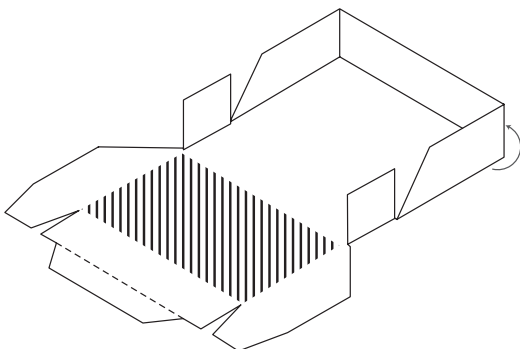
Step 14:

Bend the back sides up to a 90 degree angle.



Step 15:

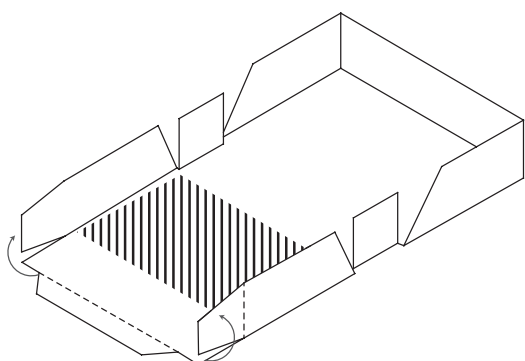
Bend the back tabs inwards and use glue on the back facing the panel. It is suggested that glue is only applied to the outward sides of the tabs.



Step 16:

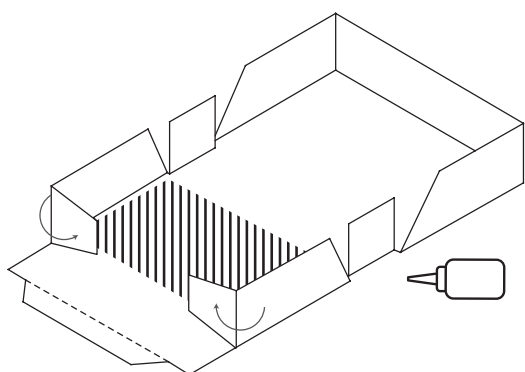
Attach the base to complete a half of the box.





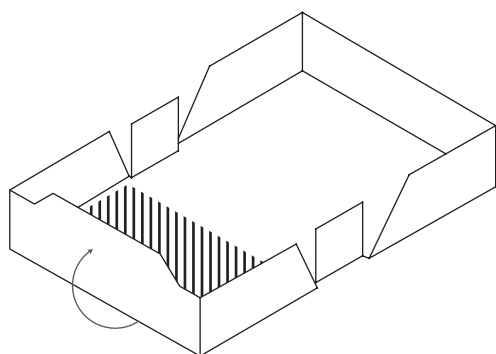
Step 17:

Bend the front tabs upwards.



Step 18:

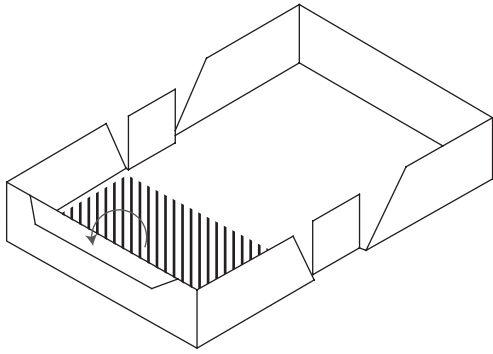
Bend the tabs inwards and glue on them to attach the final piece of the box.



Step 19:

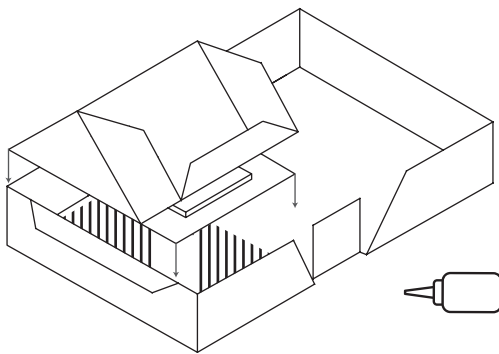
Attach the tab.





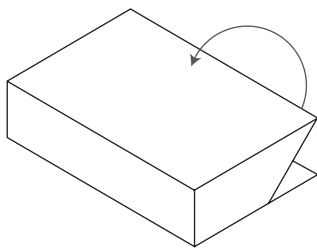
Step 20:

Bend down the tab and you are nearly done.



Step 21:

Glue the card mount to middle of the diagonally lined box.



Step 22:

Finally close the box by bending the middle scores. Congratulations you have built your own shuffle & play playing card box.
